- 71% of young adults in France, 54% in the U.S., and 26% in Nigeria get their news from social media. (Pew Research Center)
- After reading fake news and real news, over 30% of students said the fake news was more trustworthy. (Stanford)
- Political coverage gets low ratings for fairness in France, Germany, the U.K., the U.S., and countries in the Middle East, Africa, Asia and Latin America. (Pew Research Center)
